Rubric and Criteria Outline for all oral tasks.

Guidelines for marking

90-100% Marking criteria all met.

80-89% Marking criteria all met. One or two minor mistakes.

79-79% Marking criteria met with a few minor mistakes

60-69% Criteria features mostly present. Minor mistakes with less than three major mistake.

50-59% Criteria features present. Minor mistakes with mostly major mistakes.

40-49% Criteria not met. Minor mistakes with mostly major mistakes.

30-39% Criteria not met. Mostly major mistakes with minor mistakes.

<29% Criteria not met. Work consists of predominantly major mistakes.
