# LEARNING OUTCOMES

# 1. Icebreaker- Battleships

This game is called battleships. I want each one of you to have a name of your ship. There will be a category of vocabulary; your job is to defend your ships from the attacks. Every student must find their own words. The lexical area for example, "Health problems". You will be given 1-2 minutes to find as many possible words as you can and memorize them.

I will start the game by calling a ship's name, for example the ship name is "THE CALIFORNIAN". The category can change for the next round. In the last round there will be two big groups battling to be the winner.

When I start the game by calling a ship's name, for example the ship name is "THE CALIFORNIAN", the captain of THE CALIFORNIAN must reply with a word from the category given, for example he says "Flu" and then he calls out the name of another ship and the captain of the ship called must reply and do the same thing. No word can be repeated. If the captain is late to reply (more than 2 seconds) or repeat the word the ship is sunk.

# Main competency skill- Learning health phrasal verbs- auction

Before beginning the auction, let's have a quick recap of the phrasal verbs we learnt in the previous class.

A phrasal verb is a combination of 2 words, usually a verb and a preposition, that create a phrase with a different meaning. Phrasal verbs indicate actions. Such as- *turn down*, *come across* and *run into*. Now let's have a look at some health related phrasal verbs-

## 1. Pass away

- **Meaning:** Die
- **Example:** *His mother **passed away** last year.*

## 1. Run over

- **Meaning:** Hit by a vehicle
- **Example:** *Two children were **run over** and killed.*

# Learning health phrasal verbs

## Break out

- **Meaning:** Develop skin sores or irritation
- **Example:** *The measles caused me to **break out** in a rash.*

## 4. Fight off

- **Meaning:** Resist an illness
- **Example:** *I'm trying to **fight off** a cold.*

## Learning health phrasal verbs

Phrasal verb-

BREAK OUT and it means to

## Learning health phrasal verbs

The phrasal verb is PASS OUT- It means to faint or lose consciousness



## Learning health phrasal verbs

This phrasal verb is- **THROW UP** and it means to vomit....



## Learning health phrasal verbs

WORK-OUT-means to train the body by physical exercise



## Learning health phrasal verbs

This phrasal verb is DOSE UP which means to give a measured amount of medicine to someone.



# PHRASAL VERBS AUCTION

Now let's have a look at the rules of the phrasal verb auction-

1. Each one of you will get budget of Rs. 1000.
2. You will bid in increments of Rs. 100.
3. Every sentence will be auctioned away to the highest bidder.
4. If you run out of money, you will have to stop bidding.
5. The winner of the bid will give the meaning of the phrasal verb and also the sentence. If he/she can, they get their money back, and can double down by using it correctly in a sentence.
6. If they cannot, the second highest bidder gets a chance. Then if they are also unsuccessful, the next highest bidder gets a chance, and so on, until someone gets it right. When all phrasal verbs have been defined, the winner is the one with the most money.

## Disease and health board game

Each player will take turn to roll the dice and move their counter along the board. When a player lands on a square, they will read the problem and give their responses.

If it's grammatically correct and appropriate, the player stays on the square. If not, the player must go back to their previous square. The next player then rolls the dice and so on. If a player lands on a square that another student has previously landed on, they must give different answers from before. The first player to reach the finish wins the game.
